NEW DEFIBRILLATORS

Donations raised during the Seven Summits Challenge in Toronto have helped buy four automated external defibrillators.

The money was raised by the fundraising efforts of Jean Guy Belzile. He was the top fundraiser in the province, collecting more than \$26,000 to climb the stairs of the seven tallest buildings in Toronto in February.

A presentation will be held at Cite des Jeunes at 10 a. m. today.

Some of the new locations equipped with defibrillators include North Bay Indian Friendship Centre, Nipissing Parry Sound District Health Unit and St. Rita's Catholic Church.

The Old Age Club in Bonfield is also being considered as a possible location.
